



COVID Update

Dear Residents, Tenants, and Families,

On Monday, January 3rd we tested employees at both St. John's locations; we also tested The Woodlands residents and The Meadows tenants on Monday. Our testing revealed that we had 2 staff members test positive at The Meadows, 1 staff member at The Woodlands, 1 staff member at Luther Place, 1 contracted employee and 1 employee who serve at both Luther Place and The Woodlands.

We continue to see the national and local COVID virus infection rate reflected in our own. As a way of stemming off the spread of the virus, we continue to encourage the use of masks and becoming vaccinated.

The CDC recommends that people who test positive for COVID-19 should isolate for 5 days if they test positive and have no symptoms. In our facilities, we ask that visitors should continue to follow prior CDC guidelines and postpone visits to 10 days without symptoms.

Since my arrival on Monday, I have been blessed to meet much of the staff, residents, and tenants of St. John's Lutheran Community and found many warm hearts that have cut the chill of the winter weather. I look forward to being with you for the next month.
