Dear Residents, Tenants, and Families,

On Monday, November 22, we tested residents at both St. John's nursing homes, and I'm very happy to report that all tests came back negative for the Covid virus. We also tested employees on Monday, and two employees that work at the Woodlands tested positive for the Covid virus.

The guidelines have changed related to staff or residents that test positive, and we are no longer required to restrict visits when a resident, tenant or employee tests positive for the Covid virus. Visits are allowed in all of St. John's buildings, and I do not anticipate that we will have to restrict visitations in the future. As we enter into the holiday season, this is a very welcome change to the visitor guidelines.

Visitors are still required to follow common infection control practices such as wearing a mask and sanitizing hands while visiting. Visitors are also strongly encouraged to get vaccinated against the Covid virus. Vaccination helps to protect the residents, tenants and our employees from the Covid virus.
