Dear Residents, Tenants, and Families,

We tested staff at the Luther Place site on Monday, December 27, and all test results came back negative for the Covid virus.

We tested staff and nursing home residents at the Fountain Lake site and one Woodland resident tested positive for the Covid virus, and two employees tested positive. One employee works at the Woodlands and the other employee has duties throughout the Fountain Lake site.

In order to stop, or at least slow the spread of the Covid virus at the Woodlands, we will not be mixing second and third floor residents during activities.

On Thursday, December 30, we will be testing Woodlands residents and the employees at both St. John's locations.

Visitors are still allowed at all St. John's buildings. To protect the residents and tenants that live at St. John's, we encourage all visitors and all St. John's employees to get vaccinated. Please wear a mask whenever out in public, physically distance yourself from others when possible, and wash or sanitize your hands throughout the day. I know that many of us are getting tired of dealing with the Covid virus, but these are basic precautions. It doesn't require a lot of time or energy to take these basic precautions.
