Dear Residents, Tenants, and Families,

Here is a recap of the Covid testing from this week. On Monday, we had one Woodlands resident that tested positive for the Covid virus, and two employees from the Fountain Lake site that tested positive. All employee test results from the St. John's Luther Place location came back negative.

On Thursday, December 30, we tested Woodland residents, and St. John's employees at both St. John's locations. None of the Woodlands residents tested positive. We had a Meadows employee and an employee at the Fountain Lake site that tested positive for the Covid virus on Thursday.

The next round of testing will be on Monday, January 3<sup>rd</sup>. We will be testing employees at both St. John's locations, and we will also be testing Woodlands residents and Meadows tenants on Monday. As reported by local and national news outlets, the Covid virus is spreading rapidly throughout the United States, and we are seeing this reflected in our test results.

This is the last Covid update that I will be writing for St. John's. On Monday, January 3, the interim CEO / Administrator will be starting at St. John's. Darrin Radeke will serve as the interim CEO / Administrator through the month of January. February 1, 2022 will be the start date for the new permanent CEO / Administrator.
