



COVID-19 Update  
November 2, 2020

Dear Luther Place Residents and Families,

We have received notification that one of our therapy staff member's has tested positive for COVID-19. The employee was wearing all appropriate personal protective equipment during their time in the building and did not have any resident interaction. We will continue to monitor our residents and staff closely for any signs and symptoms of COVID-19. The staff member will be in quarantine for at least 14 days, and longer if they continue to have symptoms.

We have notified the Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) that one of our therapy staff member's has tested positive for COVID-19. The MDH will require us to test all employees for the COVID-19 virus once a week until we know that this virus is behind us. Employee testing will be ongoing until we have gone 14 days without an employee or resident that tests positive for the virus.

COVID-19 testing will also be available for the residents. We strongly encourage nursing home residents to be tested weekly. This virus spreads quickly and easily, and we won't know for certain if an individual resident is COVID-19 free without being tested.

Friends and family visits will be suspended for residents that live at Luther Place for at least 14 days. We know this is not easy but we need to do everything possible to keep everyone safe and healthy.

Our goal at this time is to keep COVID-19 from spreading any further to our residents, tenants, and employees.
