

Covid Update February 3, 2021

Dear St. John's Residents, Tenants, and Families,

Today we were notified that a staff member who works at the Woodlands was tested externally and is positive for COVID-19. This staff member is having mild symptoms and will be quarantined for a minimum of 10 days. We have not received results from Monday's testing for Fountain Lake yet, I will keep you updated when we receive those. Unfortunately, we will have to suspend Family and Friends visits for Fountain Lake at this time, Essential Caregiver and Compassionate Care visits are able continue.

We have received all of the test results from Monday for Luther Place and all are negative. This is a great sign, this shows that we have stopped the spread of the virus that was going on in the building. Essential Caregiver visits at Luther Place have now resumed. We are glad to see loved ones back in the building. Please continue to follow the visitation rules we have put in place to keep your loved ones and our staff safe.

Essential Caregiver Rules

Visitation time limit - 3 hour

Screened prior to every visit
Wash/Sanitize hands before, during and after visit
Sanitize resident's room after visit prior to leaving
Must wear name tag, eye protection, medical grade
face mask
Must stay in resident's room and not be in public
areas
Can take residents for walks outside
Must make appointments at least 24 hours in
advance

Compassionate Care Visit Reminders

Screened prior to every visit

Wash/Sanitize hands before, during and after visit Sanitize resident's room after visit prior to leaving Must wear face mask Must stay in resident's room and not be in public areas
Can visit regardless of COVID status in the building No appointment needed
Visit must be approved by Administrator or DON Only 2 visitors at a time
