Dear St. John's Residents, Tenants, and Families,

Yesterday we tested staff at both campuses, this afternoon we were informed of two staff members that tested positive for the Covid-19 virus. One of the staff member's works at both campuses and is vaccinated, but did not have Covid symptoms. The other staff member works at Fountain Lake but has not been in the building this week, is vaccinated, and did not have Covid symptoms either.

We will need to limit visitors at the Woodlands, Meadows 2, Waters Edge, Luther Place, and Knutson Place to Essential Caregivers and Compassionate Care visits. We will be testing staff and residents again on Thursday and next Monday and will re-open to Friends & Family visitors as soon as we can.

The Covid-19 virus continues to spread throughout Freeborn County and all of us are susceptible to becoming infected by this virus. The most important steps that we can take to protect ourselves and our family from this virus are: 1) get vaccinated, 2) wear a mask when out in public, and 3) wash or sanitize our hands frequently throughout the day.
