On Monday and Thursday this week, we tested employees for the Covid-19 virus and none of our employees tested positive. We were pretty excited about these great test results. This afternoon we were informed of an allied healthcare provider that tested positive for the Covid-19 virus. This provider provides services at the Woodlands and is vaccinated, but did not have Covid symptoms.

We will need to limit visitors at the Woodlands to Essential Caregivers and Compassionate Care visits. Hopefully, we can reopen the Woodlands to visitors late next Thursday after we have received test results from testing on Monday and Thursday.

The Covid-19 virus continues to spread throughout Freeborn County and all of us are susceptible to becoming infected by this virus. The most important steps that we can take to protect ourselves and our family from this virus are: 1) get vaccinated, 2) wear a mask when out in public, and 3) wash or sanitize our hands frequently throughout the day.
