Dear St. John's Residents, Tenants and Families,

Resident, Tenant and Staff COVID Testing

I'm happy to report again that we do not have any residents, tenants, or staff that have tested positive for the COVID-19 virus. Hopefully, in the weeks and months ahead of us, I can continue to report that we've managed to keep this nasty virus out of all St. John's buildings.

<u>Infection Control Survey</u>

The Minnesota Department of Health (MDH) is going into nursing homes and assisted living buildings and doing infection control inspections. On May 6 two inspectors showed up at the Luther Place Nursing Home and on May 7 two inspectors showed up at the Fountain Lake site. We've been following Center for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines very closely, so we did very well with the inspections at both sites.

Mother's Day Parade

We have a Mother's Day Parade scheduled for Saturday, May 9th. Families are welcome to participate in the parade. We will line up at Three Oaks Winery at 1:15pm, and then drive around Eagle View Circle at the Fountain Lake site. We will then make our way to the Highway 13 campus, and drive around the block at this location.

We are still under visitor restrictions so parade participants cannot go inside any of the St. John's buildings. The Minnesota Department of Health and the CDC will make the decision to lift the visitor restrictions.

The reception desk at the Highway 13 site is located at the Office/Knutson Place entrance. The reception desk at the Fountain Lake site is located at the main entrance of the campus.
